## TECA Venue Facilities

The Event Complex Aberdeen provides the following facilities to assist customers with access requirements:



**Changing Places** toilet on concourse level – providing a spacious environment that is safe, clean and accessible to all



**Accessible Toilets** on all levels



**Accessible Parking** on both ground and subterranean levels



**Induction Hearing Loops** available



**Accessible Seating** on all levels including within our main arena

## Booking Tickets for a Concert

Here at TECA we provide designated areas for accessibility patrons at all live concerts and shows.

Please book in advance of the show date by calling the **Ticketmaster Accessible Seating line** on **0800 988 4440**.

**Ticketmaster's service hours** are as follows;

Monday – Friday 9:00am – 6:00pm

Saturday 10:30am – 3.30pm

### Seating

Accessible seating for an all seated show can be located in the following areas:

- Block A + E on the flat floor
- Accessible platform located behind Block P on the flat floor
- Balcony blocks 202, 204, 205, 206, 207 and 209 located on the second floor

For an all standing show an accessible viewing platform will be situated at the rear of the arena next to the mixer desk.

## Other Accessibility Information

### Medical and Dietary Requirements

If you are attending an event at TECA and have any medical requirements – please let the event organiser know and they can pass on the details to the dedicated TECA event manager.

If you are attending a concert or show and have any medical requirements – please contact **info@teca.co.uk** and detail which show you will be attending along with your request.

At TECA we have a food and beverage policy that does not allow food and drink to be brought into the arena. However we can make allowances in exceptional circumstances for medical conditions.

### Access to Performance

To allow us to make any reasonable adjustments to provide any additional services please allow us 4 weeks' notice prior to the event date.
